Senator Brown asked:

There have been reports that some courses of study will be excluded from the scope of exemption to allow young people to receive income support. Is this true? a. If so, what courses are not within the scope of the exemption? b. Who will decide which courses?

Answer:

Under the *Social Security Act 1991*, an approved course of education or study for Youth Allowance and Austudy is defined as a course determined under section 5D of the *Student Assistance Act 1973* to be a secondary or tertiary course. The Student Assistance (Education Institutions and Courses) Determination 2009 (No.2) can be found at http://www.comlaw.gov.au/Details/F2013C01032.

The Minister for Social Services determines which courses will fall within the scope of the exemption.
