- f. duration on payment (>1yr, 1-2, 2-5, 5-10, 10+);
- g. number and percentage reporting other employment;
- h. number and percentage of people on part rate due to means test;
- i. reported hours of work undertaken;
- j. reported income from employment;
- k. reported income from other assets; and
- 1. other payments received.
