- 4. Will funding be solely allocated to Migrant Resource Centres, rather than both MRCs and ethnic specific organisations?

- 1. Funding for settlement grants of around \$183 million has been allocated over four years from 1 July 2014, under *Outcome 2: Families and Communities, Programme 2.1 Settlement services* (page 98 of the Department of Social Services Portfolio Budget Statements 2014-15).
