Answer:

- a) The Department's Paid Parental Leave scheme evaluation, currently nearing finalisation, examines the patterns for mothers' workforce participation and return to work after taking parental leave.
- b) The Department considers a wide range of issues when developing policy, and notes that child care is the responsibility of the Department of Education.
