DSS Grants – A New Way of Working

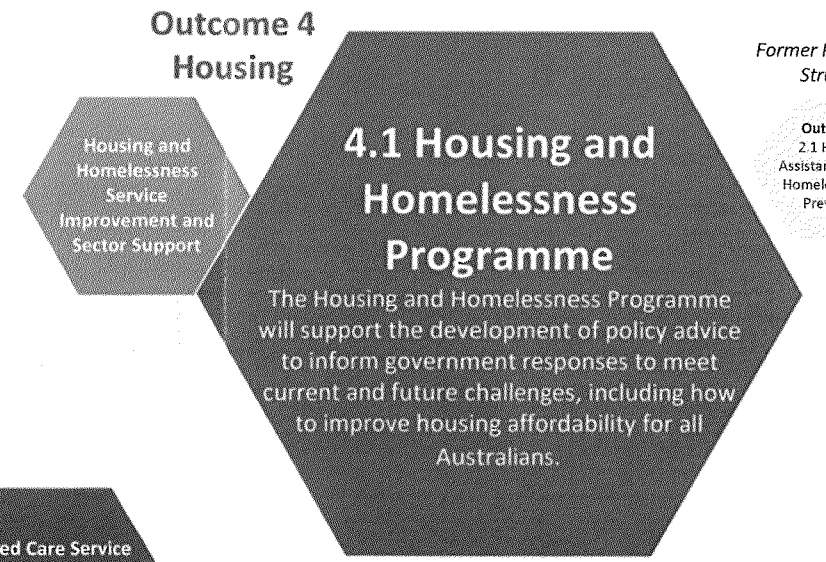
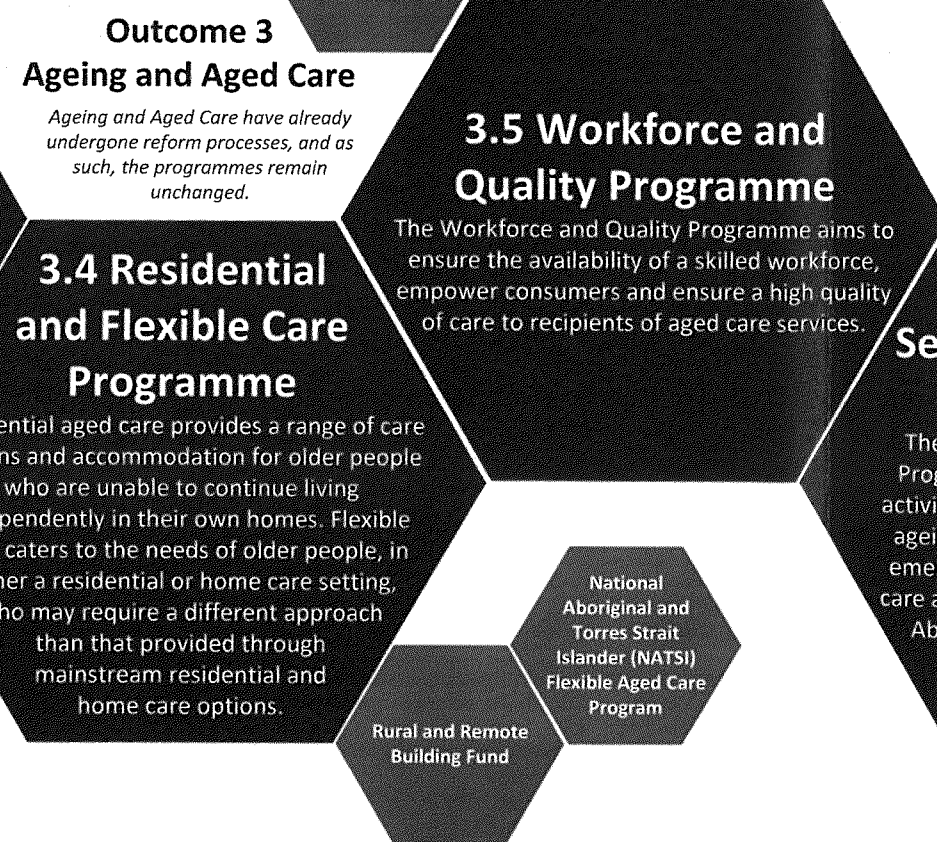
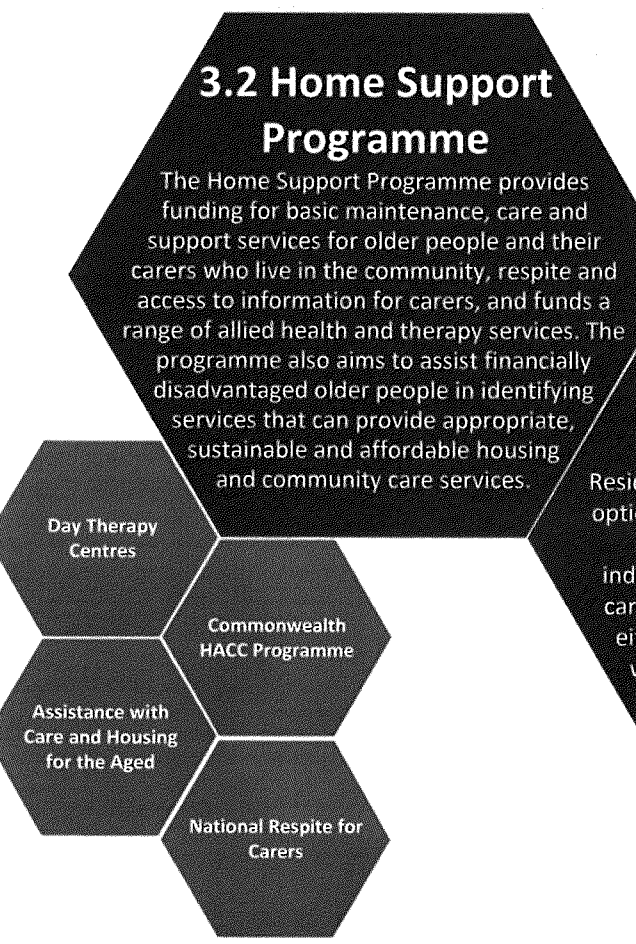
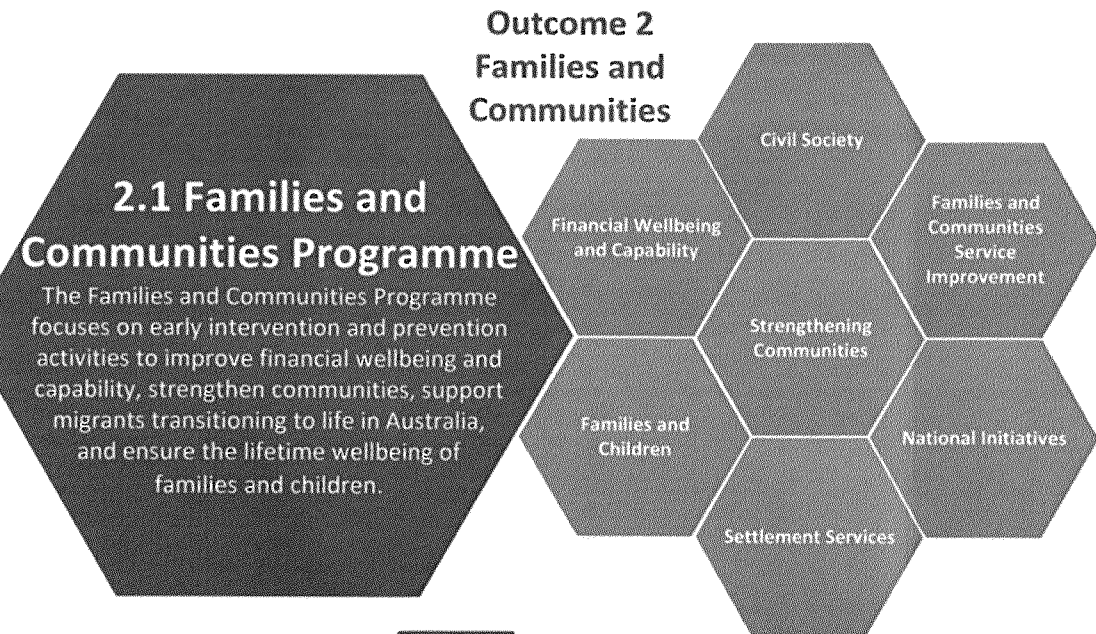
