Question:

The Mason Review notes that if the Medical Rural Bonded Scholarships (MRBS) cannot be suitably completed, the government should look to implement less harsh penalties in the form of a buyout for graduates who are unable to complete the MRBS. Will the government do this?

Answer:

The Government has decided to close the Medical Rural Bonded Scholarships (MRBS) to new entrants from the end of 2015. In future, bonded medical places will be offered to students under a different programme which permits graduates to 'buy out' the return of service obligation.
