If (the trip) was provided by WADA, would you be able to give us a cost breakdown on that trip?

**Answer:**

In April 2015 the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) Chief Executive Officer, Ben McDevitt travelled to Montreal to attend the inaugural meeting of WADA sponsored National Anti-Doping Organisation (NADO) Ad Hoc Working Group.

The cost of the airfares and accommodation (approximately \$9,800) was covered by WADA.

The cost to ASADA was \$789 which covered domestic and international meal and incidental costs in accordance with the Agency's international travel policy.
