Funding agreements are in place with 31 Primary Health Networks (PHN) for the provision of primary mental health and Indigenous mental health services for 2016-17 to 2017-18, through a new flexible primary mental health care funding pool. The funding to each PHN is provided in the funding table below. Funding amounts are GST exclusive.

It should be noted that the funding table includes funding for the PHN Lead Site trial activity for each respective PHN, however does not include new funding announced as part of the election commitment.
