Please provide a breakdown of the people who will have a liquid assets waiting period by payment type and which income bands you think they will fall in.

### Answer:

The information provided below indicates the number of claimants expected to be impacted in 2018-19 by the increase in the Liquid Assets Waiting Period by payment type against their level of liquid asset holdings.

Claimants with liquid assets between \$12,000 and \$18,000 for singles, and between \$24,000 and \$36,000 for partnered people and those with children, will serve an additional waiting period of between 1 and 12 weeks, based on the level of liquid assets held.

An additional 13 week waiting period will be served by those with liquid assets at or above \$18,000 or \$36,000.
