**Senator Skye Kakoschke-Moore asked:**

Do you have a breakdown of those people who have been subjected to a personal form of labour exploitation, that were assisted? How many of those people were located in South Australia?

**Answer:**

From 1 March 2009 to 1 May 2017, 27 people have been assisted by the Support for Trafficked People Program for personal forms of labour exploitation. Five of these 27 people were located in South Australia.
