## **Topic: National Disability Strategy**

#### Senator Carol Brown asked:

Footnote 9 (P. 8 Driving Action 2015 - 2018) states there was an original, sixth action area focusing on the appointment of a Champion Minister from mainstream portfolios to take a leadership role in support of the strategy's implementation. What was the Department/ Government's reason for the discontinuation of the proposal? When was the decision taken?

### Answer:

The Council of Australian Governments (COAG) Disability Reform Council agreed to discontinue this action in April 2016.

As reported on page 12 of the 2010–2020 National Disability Strategy Progress Report to the Council of Australian Governments 2014 "since the implementation of the strategy in 2011, the appointment and retention of Disability Champions has been challenging, due to changes in government portfolio responsibilities, state and territory elections, and a streamlined COAG ministerial council system."

Disability ministers across all jurisdictions maintain a leadership role in driving the National Disability Strategy within their jurisdictions.
