On the 9 November 2016 the Australian National Audit Office released a report titled "National Disability Insurance Scheme – Management of the Transition of the Disability Services Market". In the report it was stated that there was no consultation with external stakeholders. Will the Government release the evaluation reports on how effective and what the learnings were from the trial sites in particular the Barclay region?
