The gender split of clients on the Support for Trafficked People Program (the Support Program) from 1 March 2009 to 1 June 2017 is provided in the table below:

Due to the risk of clients being identified, it is not possible to disaggregate the ages of clients into ranges smaller than '18 and over' and '17 and under'.

224 people aged 18 years and over at the time of referral have been assisted by the Support Program between 1 March 2009 to 1 June 2017.

35 people aged 17 years and under at the time of referral have been assisted by the Support Program between 1 March 2009 to 1 June 2017.
