**Senator Siewert** asked:

**Ms Rundle:** I should also reconcile for the record that, before, I talked about \$30.3 million having been committed. I think those two figures will be the difference between in-kind and non-in-kind.

**Senator SIEWERT:** The 26 and the 30?

**Ms Rundle:** I suspect so. I will check and come back. But I did not want to convey the wrong

**Answer:**

As at 31 March 2017, \$30.3 million in funding was committed in current participant plans for Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA). \$6.0 million was in-kind (20 per cent) and \$24.3 million was cash (80 per cent).

\$26.2 million was the amount committed in current participant plans for SDA as at 31 December 2016.
