Senator Kakoschke-Moore, asked:

Does a complex case manager stay with a family, longer than a planner would?

Answer:

Both Local Area Coordinators and Support Coordinators will spend more time with a participant than a National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) planner would as they assist participants to implement their plan, connect to services and supports, and work with the participant to monitor effectiveness of supports.

The NDIA planner's primary role is to develop a participant's National Disability Insurance Scheme plan and to conduct the review of their plan, usually on a 12 monthly basis.
