Senator Adams asked:

Gyprock is being used for internal walls instead of precast concrete or bricks because of environmental conditions. Having seen a demonstration of a new house with the wall kicked in, where is that going to go?

Answer:

The dwellings in Blackstone have been constructed with internal walls of fibre cement rather than gyprock as this has proven to be more durable over the life of the dwelling.
