Question

NTER FIGURES

Senator BOYCE—We are on the NTER at the moment. I am looking at similar job creation in non Northern Territory Indigenous communities.

Mr Griew—We can give you some figures that are not exactly comparable but we can give you figures relating to the government service delivery—conversions of CDEP and under the government service delivery national partnership agreement.

Senator BOYCE—Okay, we will do that later.

Answer

Under the National Jobs Creation Package a total of 1 538 jobs for Indigenous Australians have been created by the Commonwealth and jurisdictions. The 1 235 Commonwealth positions include: 135 municipal services positions, 76 sport and recreation positions, 266 community care positions, 299 education support worker positions, 22 night patrol positions, 111 ranger positions and 326 arts worker positions.

The 303 state funded positions are in a wide variety of essential service roles. A breakdown of these positions by role is not available.
