## CDEP

Senator PAYNE—Are the 1,008 that are registered with employment service providers currently in the active job market? Is that the terminology we would be using? Ms Wood—Yes. They are in the employment services system receiving support to build their skills and find employment. Senator PAYNE—How are they spread across the states and territories? Ms Wood—I do not have that information with me, but we could get it for you. Senator PAYNE—Could you take that on notice please. Ms Wood—Yes. Senator PAYNE—For those 1,008 people I would be interested to know which particular providers are involved in that support process. Ms Wood—Yes. Mr Griew—These are ex-CDEP clients in outer regional areas. That is the way we are talking about it. It is not in the very remote areas. Senator PAYNE—No, I understand. Senator SIEWERT—When you are taking that on notice can you provide a breakdown of gender. Or do you have that now? Ms Wood—No, I do not have that now. Senator SIEWERT—If you could provide that it would be good. Ms Wood—Yes.

#### Answer

Revised data for 23 September 2010 indicate 1,029 of the 1,964 former CDEP participants were registered with Job Services Australia. The state and gender breakdown of the former CDEP participants registered with Job Services Australia is shown in the table below.
