Senator Scullion asked:

Since Mr Calma was appointed as the National Coordinator Tackling Indigenous Smoking, how many of the 57 regional tobacco coordinators, and, I understand, up to 171 tobacco action workers have been employed?

Answer:

Mr Calma was appointed as the National Coordinator Tackling Indigenous Smoking in March 2010. Since that time, the department has entered into funding agreements with organisations in the first 20 of 57 regions to initially facilitate the establishment of office space and then commence recruitment action for the Tobacco Action Workforce.

As at 15 November 2010, eight Regional Tobacco Coordinators and nine Tobacco Action Workers had been employed by these organisations.

The proposed roll-out of workers over three years across 57 regions and the ACT is:
