Question:

Provide an update for your department/agency, including what is your current compliance level, what are you doing to manage risk, what is being done to comply with the mandatory requirements and details of any department/agency specific policies and procedures.

Answer:

The Department of Health and Ageing is fully compliant with 29 of 33 mandatory requirements of the Protective Security Policy Framework (PSPF) and partially compliant with the remaining four requirements. The Department anticipates being fully compliant with the PFPS by 31 July 2013.

Risk is managed through established processes and governed by Executive Committees. The Department maintains a strategic documentation framework, the contents of which are subject to ongoing review in accordance with the PSPF.
