### Question:

- a) What are the current funding arrangements between the government and Transplant Australia?
- b) How much has the Commonwealth contributed to Transplant Australia in each financial year since 2008?
- c) How much has OTA contributed to Transplant Australia each year?

#### Answer:

a) The Australian Organ and Tissue Donation and Transplantation Authority (AOTDTA) entered into a three-year funding agreement with Transplant Australia for the period 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14 to provide funding for the staging of the 2012 and 2014 Australian Transplant Games and to contribute to the Australian participation in the 2013 World Transplant Games. The three-year funding agreement is for a total of \$657,227.27 (GST excl).

In addition, Transplant Australia is eligible to apply for funding under the AOTDTA's open competitive Community Awareness Grants program. In the most recent round for activities to support DonateLife Week 2013, Transplant Australia was successful in receiving funding of \$16,930 (GST excl) to conduct outreach activities targeting university students.
