**Question:**

- a) What is the current full-time-equivalent staff working in the GP Super Clinics branch for each of the years over the forward estimates?
- b) What is the total combined salary of all staff within the GP Super Clinics branch for each year over the forward estimates?

**Answer:**

- a) As at the end of September 2012, there was approximately 33.8 full-time equivalent staff within the GP Super Clinics Branch in the Department of Health and Ageing. Staffing is not allocated over the forward estimates.
- b) The budget allocated for 2012-13 for GP Super Clinics staff costs was \$3,907,000, which includes wages and salaries. These are budgeted on an annual basis and are not allocated over the forward estimates.
