Is it still the case that an organisation will get only one letter from your agency if it gets more than one grant? And I am fairly confident that some of them will have more than one. I would probably have to take on notice the degree to which we are able to streamline the aged care arrangement.

Answer:

Funded organisations will receive a single letter from the Department of Health and Ageing. Approximately 270 organisations will receive a letter of offer in relation to multiple in-scope funding agreements. Approximately 1070 organisations will receive a letter of offer in relation to a single funding agreement.
