Senator Cash asked:

Please provide figures on how many people have accessed services under the Communities for Children in Targeted Locations initiative and provide a breakdown by location.

Answer:

For the period April to September 2012, the total number of clients who accessed Communities for Children services through the Helping Young Parents measure was 106. A total of 70 clients accessed Communities for Children services through the Supporting Jobless Families measure for the period July to September 2012.

The breakdown by location of the number of people accessing services under the Communities for Children in Targeted Locations initiative cannot be released for privacy reasons.
