Can you indicate the number and percentage of people in receipt of the sickness allowance and in receipt of other payments?

Answer:

The number of recipients of Sickness Allowance, as at 27 September 2013, was 7,501. Those in receipt of Sickness Allowance are not eligible to receive other primary income support payments at the same time. The majority (99%) of Sickness Allowance recipients received other supplementary payments as tabled below.
