Since Budget Estimates in June 2014:

- a) How much has been spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers / Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio to date?
 - 1) Detail the items provided to the minister's office.
 - 2) Please specify how many reams of paper have been supplied to the Minister's Office.
- b) How much has been spent on departmental stationery requirements to date.
- c) Has any customised stationery been requested or provided to the Minister or Ministerial Staff? If yes, please include a photo/scan, detail the type of stationery, date it was requested, date it was provided and the cost.

Answer:

- a) Between 6 June 2014 and 11 November 2014, the total expenditure on stationery requirements was \$6,720.80 (excluding GST).
 - 1) Items include general stores and stationery supplies such as paper, envelopes and pens. To provide a detailed list of all stationery would involve an unreasonable diversion of departmental resources.
