Question:

a) How many cosmetics ingredients have had manufacturers'/importers' applications to NICNAS to accept overseas non-animal tested validated tested data-sets accepted instead of animal-tested datasets?

b) Please provide the details of which ones were successful and which not successful, and why.

Answer:

- a) In the last financial year (2013-14), there were six Standard notifications completed for cosmetic ingredients in which a validated non-animal test method (e.g. the EpiSkin dermal irritation method) was submitted for at least one of the required toxicological data endpoints, in place of animal test data, and/or historical animal test data on analogue chemicals were accepted as a variation to scheduled data requirements.
- b) All applications in 2013-14 were successful.
