Question:

Does the scientific evidence need to show the changes of effects on an elite athlete versus say a sedentary office worker? If not, why not?

Answer:

For health claims on electrolyte drinks, the scientific evidence should be relevant to the identified purpose of these drinks (that is for the rapid replacement of fluid, carbohydrates and electrolytes lost as a result of sustained, strenuous physical activity). Therefore, the food-health relationship must be demonstrated in a population group undertaking sustained, strenuous physical activity.
