Question:

1. Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014 how much has been spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio to date?
 - a) Detail the items provided to the minister's office.
 - b) Please specify how many reams of paper have been supplied to the Minister's office.
2. How much has been spent on departmental stationery requirements to date.
3. Has any customised stationery been requested or provided to the Minister or Ministerial Staff? If yes, please include a photo/scan, detail the type of stationery, date it was requested, date it was provided and the cost.

Answer:

1. For the period 1 June 2014 to 30 September 2014 the amount spent on stationery requirements for the Ministers was \$2,382.
 - a) General office stationery items are provided to the Ministers' offices, e.g. pens, pencils, folders, notepads.
 - b) 110 reams of A4 paper have been supplied to the Ministers' offices.
2. For the period 1 June 2014 to 30 September 2014 the amount spent on stationery requirements for the Department of Health was \$153,097.
3. No customised stationery has been requested or provided to the Ministers or ministerial staff.
