Question:

- 1. Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014 how much has been spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio to date?
- a) Detail the items provided to the minister's office.
- b) Please specify how many reams of paper have been supplied to the Minister's office.
- 2. How much has been spent on departmental stationary requirements to date.
- 3. Has any customised stationery been requested or provided to the Minister or Ministerial Staff? If yes, please include a photo/scan, detail the type of stationery, date it was requested, date it was provided and the cost.

Answer:

- 1. For the period 1 June 2014 to 30 September 2014 the amount spent on stationery requirements for the Ministers was \$2,382.
 - a) General office stationery items are provided to the Ministers' offices, e.g. pens, pencils, folders, notepads.
 - b) 110 reams of A4 paper have been supplied to the Ministers' offices.
- 2. For the period 1 June 2014 to 30 September 2014 the amount spent on stationery requirements for the Department of Health was \$153,097.
- 3. No customised stationery has been requested or provided to the Ministers or ministerial staff.
