#### **Answer:**

Additional controls have been implemented to further reduce the risks of unauthorised changes to personal details via Medicare online accounts. These include increased requirements that need to be met by customers to initially access their Medicare online account and contacting customers to provide an opportunity to confirm the validity of any changes made to their banking details.
