Can you detail the budgets for primary healthcare networks and their scope of practice?

Answer:

Primary Health Networks (PHNs) currently receive three funding streams:

- <u>Operational</u> supports the operations and maintenance of PHNs including: premises, governance, board, core staff, and office administrative costs.
- <u>Flexible</u> enables PHNs to respond to identified national priorities as determined by Government, and to respond to PHN specific priorities by purchasing/commissioning required services.
- <u>Programme</u> supports a specific range of services and initiatives including for after hours, mental health, Indigenous health and health workforce.

The Department of Health provides funding for these streams as in the table below:
