# **Question:**

What is the rate of growth in ACFI subsidies (by % and by \$) - 2013, 2014, 2015

#### **Answer:**

Growth in Aged Care Funding Instrument (ACFI) subsidies can be considered in nominal terms (actual amount paid) or in real terms (ie prices adjusted to remove the effect of indexation).

The table below gives the average ACFI claim for the year, in nominal terms.

	2011-12	2012-13	2013-14	2014-15 <sup>1</sup>
Average ACFI	\$130.95	\$135.75	\$142.70	\$156.21
Year on Year Growth		3.7%	5.1%	9.5%

<sup>1.</sup> The 2014-15 figures includes the redirection of the Workforce Supplement which increased daily ACFI subsidy rates by 2.4%.
