Senator Rachel Siewert asked:

- 1. How much funding was provided for advocacy services under the External Merits review support component in the past year for persons wishing to seek external merits review on a decision of the National Disability Insurance Agency?
- 2. How much funding was provided for legal assistance for external merits review in both the AAT and Federal Court?
- 3. How many people are estimated to have been assisted by both streams of funding?

Answer:

- 1. In 2014-15, funding of \$777,135 was provided for advocacy supports under the External Merits Review- Support Component (EMR-SC).
- 2. In 2014-15, funding of \$147,502 was accessed for legal assistance under the EMR-SC for AAT cases. The funding provided under the EMR-SC may not be used for the provision of legal services in jurisdictions beyond the AAT.
- 3. In 2014-15, 18 people benefited from individual EMR-SC support through the AAT process. A larger number of people have been indirectly assisted through information, education and capacity building by EMR-SC providers.
