	Moore	18	Ms Bruce: It is dss.gov.au (replace grants.gov.au with dss.gov.au).
	Moore	19	Ms Pondes: It is at this point. As the directory has been established, the actual ongoing updating of it is minimal (<i>replace</i> is being with has been).
	Moore	20	Ms Bruce: It will be uploaded regularly as funding agreements are executed on dss.gov.au and then will be translated into the department's service directory (<i>replace</i> grants.gov.au with dss.gov.au).
	Moore	21	Ms Bruce: From memory, not all. But we do have a separate reporting process on that that is due at 31 March each year (delete to the parliament).
