On 'transplant tourism' the answer says "While not illegal, any attempt to exploit the vulnerable for the purpose of retrieving organs is strongly condemned by all governments". a) Has the department looked into transplant tourism at all, outside of prevalence, to any question of international law or other countries that have taken action against it?

b) Is the department aware that a number of countries including Israel, Spain, and Taiwan have banned organ tourism, and USA and EU have passed strong resolutions against it?

Answer:

- a) Yes.
- b) Yes. The Department of Health is aware that some countries are implementing measures to deter people from engaging in 'transplant tourism'.

Australia is a signatory to the Declaration of Istanbul and the World Health Organizations Guiding Principles that relate to organ and tissue donation and transplantation.
