Does the 2015 medical workforce data show a decline from 2014 in the number of full-time equivalent general practitioners in Outer Regional, Remote and Very Remote areas?

Answer:

No. Medicare billing data shows an increase from 2013-14 to 2014-15 across all Modified Monash Model categories in the measure of Full-time Service Equivalent (FSE) for General Practitioners billing patient-initiated services, including in Outer Regional (MM 2-4), Remote (MM 6) and Very Remote (MM 7) areas. See table below.
