1. How many cars are owned by each Department/Agency?

5. How far did each car travel from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date?
6. How many cars are leased by each department/agency?
7. Where are the cars located?
8. What are the cars used for?
9. What is the cost of each car from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date?
10. How far did each car travel from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date?

**Answer:**

- 1-5. As at 31 January 2014, Australia Post did not own any corporate cars. All corporate cars are leased.
- 6&8. As at 31 January 2014, Australia Post leased 445 corporate cars, which are used for a variety of business-related purposes.
- 7,9&10. The details sought about corporate cars across the entire corporation are not captured on any central database. As such, Australia Post is not in a position to provide the information requested.
