Topic: Staffing profile

Senator Ludwig asked:

1. What is the current staffing profile of the Department/Agency?
2. Provide a list of staffing numbers, broken down by classification level, division, home base location (including town/city and state)

Answer:

1. As at 28 February 2014:
ACMA had 548 employees (full time equivalent, or FTE of 517.58), 506 of whom are ongoing and 42 non-ongoing;
Of the 506 ongoing employees, 420 are full-time and 86 are part-time;
Of the 42 non-ongoing employees, 34 are full-time and eight are part-time. There are also two casual staff that are not included in these figures as they have not worked for over 12 months.
