Topic: Taxi Costs

Senator Ludwig, Joe asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. How much did each department/agency spend on taxis during the specified period?
- 2. Provide a breakdown for each business group in each department/agency.
- 3. What are the reasons for taxi costs?
- 4. How much did the department spend on taxis during the specified period for their minister or minister's office?

Answer:

- 1. For the period 14 September 2015 to 31 January 2016, total departmental expense on taxis was \$56,666 (GST excl).
 - The Department does not record taxi expense data in a way that would readily allow for individual business groups to be identified. To attempt to provide this level of details would involve an unreasonable diversion of departmental resources.
- 2. The use of taxis is assessed on a needs basis and is subject to the same value for money considerations as all other travel undertaken by departmental staff.
