Topic: Staffing recruitment

Senator Ludwig, Joe asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. How many ongoing staff have been recruited? What classification are these staff?
- 2. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created? What classification are these staff?
- 3. How many staff have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

Answer:

- 1. Between 14 September 2015 and 29 January 2016 inclusive 2 ongoing staff were recruited, 1 APS 4 and 1 Executive Level 1.
- 2. Between 14 September 2015 and 29 January 2016 inclusive, the ACMA created 6 nonongoing positions, 2 APS 4 and 4 APS 6. As at 29 January 2016, 13 non-ongoing positions exist; 2 APS 4, 2 APS 5 and 9 APS 6.
- 3. Between 14 September 2015 and 29 January 2016 inclusive, the ACMA had 6 staff employed on a non-ongoing contract. The average length of their employment period is 7.4 months.
