Topic: Staffing recruitment

Senator Ludwig, Joe asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

1. How many ongoing staff have been recruited? What classification are these staff?
2. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created? What classification are these staff?
3. How many staff have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

Answer:

1. Two ongoing staff have been recruited to Creative Partnerships since 14 September. These staff are employed in operations and programs administration roles at a junior level. Creative Partnerships staff are not employed under the Public Service Act.
2. No non-ongoing positions exist or have been created at Creative Partnerships Australia since 14 September
3. One staff member has been employed on a contractor basis since 14 September; the contract started on 1 November and will end 30 March
