### Senator Ludwig, Joe asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. How much did the department/agency spend on temporary or contract staff?
- 2. How many temporary or contract staff have been employed?
- 3. What is the total number of temporary or contract staff currently employed?
- 4. How much was paid for agencies/companies to find temporary/contract staff?
- 5. Have there been any changes to the policies/criteria that govern the appointment of contract staff.

#### **Answer:**

- 1. SBS spent \$985,293.
- 2. 24 contractors and contributors.
- 3. 822 contractors and contributors.
- 4. To attempt to provide this level of detail (just for the agency spend) would involve an unreasonable diversion of departmental resources.
- 5. No. SBS has preferred supplier panels in place for providing contractors across the organisation. Terms & Conditions are agreed upfront. The criteria are assessed against these panels and the role description.
