**Senator Ludwig, Joe asked:**

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

1. How many documents (include the amount of copies) have been printed?
  - (a) How many of these printed documents were also published online?
2. Has the Department/Agency used external printing services for any print jobs?
  - (a) If so, what companies were used?
  - (b) How were they selected?
  - (c) What was the total cost of this printing by item?

**Answer:**

- 1-2. Australia Post has had numerous documents printed since 14 September 2015, some of which are published on its website [www.auspost.com.au](http://www.auspost.com.au). The specific details sought about documents printed across the entire Corporation are not captured on any central database.
