- 4. The ABC does not keep records of all ongoing costs against devices. However, there is no ongoing cost for: iPads (WiFi iPads), Laptops, VPN tokens.

  A default \$10 data plan is used by around 90% of smart phones and wireless cards allocated within the ABC. So the ongoing cost is approximately \$2,910 p.m.
