Topic: Workplace assessments

Senator Ludwig, Joe asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

1. How much has been spent on workplace ergonomic assessments?
 - (a) List each item of expenditure and cost
2. Have any assessments, not related to an existing disability, resulted in changes to workplace equipment or set up?
3. If so, list each item of expenditure and cost related to those changes.

Answer:

1. \$840 was spent on 24 workstation assessments.
2. Yes.
3. The following items were purchased:
 - (a) 10 x monitor risers at \$50 per monitor riser.
 - (b) 5 x foot stools at \$50 per foot stool.
 - (c) 4 x sit/stand desktops at \$450 per desk.
 - (d) 3 x chairs at \$365 per chair.
