Senator Ludwig, Joe asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

 - (c) If so, list the itemised cost for each item of expenditure
 - (d) If so, who conducted the works?

 - (f) If so, when are the works expected to be completed?

Answer:

1. Yes

- (a) SBS has engaged in upgrades to the building CCTV and access controls. It has also, installed new building security access gates, introduced new ID badges and swipe cards and is building a new security control room. Lastly, SBS has upgraded its loading dock and main entry boom gates. This was required as the building security was over 15 years old and not up to the Protective Security Policy Framework standards.
