Topic: Office Plants

Senator Ludwig, Joe asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

1. Has the department/agency purchased or leased any office plants?
 - (a) If so, list these
 - (b) If so, list the total cost for these items
 - (c) If so, list the itemised cost for each item of expenditure
 - (d) If so, where were these purchased
 - (e) If so, list the process for identifying how they would be purchased
 - (f) If so, what is the current location for these items?

Answer:

1. Yes
 - (a) 4 medium plants and 3 small plants.
 - (b) \$178 from 30th November 2015 – 29th January 2016.
 - (c) Hire contract does not itemise cost for each individual plant. For the period from 30th November 2015 – 29th January 2016 each plant cost an average of \$12.71 per month.
 - (d) Plants are not purchased. Plants are leased from Prestigious Landscapes.
 - (e) Plants have been leased through an approach to market.
 - (f) ACMA Office, Level 19, 240 Queen Street, Brisbane, QLD.
