Topic: Workers' Compensation

Senator Urquhart, Anne asked:

- 1. How many workers' compensation claims were made in the 2014/15 financial year?
- 2. How many of these claims rejected at either the initial claim or internal reconsideration stage by Australia Post?
- 3. Of the claims that were initially rejected, how many employees progressed their claims to the Administrative Tribunal?
- 4. Of the claims that were initially rejected and then proceeded to the Tribunal, how many were upheld by the Tribunal?

Answer:

- 1. 1,276 workers' compensation claims were made in 2014/15.
- 2. 346 were initially denied (59 of these were subsequently accepted at reconsideration).
- 3. 63 employees progressed their claims to the Administrative Tribunal.
- 4. 14 denied decisions were upheld by the Administrative Appeals Tribunal; 2 were varied and accepted; 4 applications were dismissed and 43 claims are pending decision.
