## Senator Ludwig asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

## Answer:

1. The offices of Minister Hunt and Minister Briggs use the Department's media monitoring service, which includes the provision of portfolio related transcripts and audio files. Costs are included in the Departmental figures outlined below.

Services to Minister Briggs were started on 20 September 2015 and stopped on 29 December 2015.

- 2. The Department of the Environment provides media monitoring services to the Australian Renewable Energy Agency, the Bureau of Meteorology, the Clean Energy Regulator, the Climate Change Authority, the Director of National Parks and the Sydney Harbour Federation Trust.
